

AV1611 Luke 5:21 Who can forgiue sinnes, but God alone?
Rev 19:8 And to her was granted, that she should bee arayed in fine linnen, cleane and white: for the fine linnen is the righteousnesse of Saints.

1610 Jesuit Rheims: Tobias 4:11 because alms delivereth from all sin, and from death, & will not suffer the soul to go into darkness.

Rev 19:8 it was granted her to be clothed with fine linen, bright and pure" --for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.





AV1611 I tell you, Nay: but except yee repent, ye shall all likewise perish.

What is repentance?

Douay Rheims 1899: No, I say to you: but unless you shall do penance, you shall all likewise perish.

What is penance?

Websters 1828 Penance: 1. The suffering, labor or pain to which a person voluntarily subjects himself, or which is imposed on him by authority as a punishment for his faults, or as an expression of penitence; such as fasting, flagellation, wearing chains, etc. penance is one of the seven sacraments of the Romish church.

2011 Catholic NAB Bible: Tobit 4:10 For almsgiving delivers from death and keeps one from entering into Darkness.

2011 Catholic NAB Bible: Sirach 3:30 As water quenches a flaming fire, so almsgiving atones for sins.¹

1610 Jesuit Rheims: Sirach 3:33 33 Water quencheth burning fire, and Alms resisteth sins:

1610 Jesuit Rheims: Tobias 4:11 because alms delivereth from all sin, and from death, & will not suffer the soul to go into darkness.

Penance: Affliction to self for forgiveness of sins.

Typical penance in Roman Church is confessing sins to a priests

And he assigns you penance.

Person Says: Bless me Father for I have sinned, it has been five years since my last confession and these are my sins: I did not listen to my Mom and Dad, I stole a pencil from school, I told two lies, I have carnally thought about and desired girls, etc.

Priest says: Say Five Our Fathers and Ten Hail Mary's and ten Acts of Contrition.

Act of Contrition: Oh My God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you. With your help I will sin no more.

Websters 1828 Repentance: 1. To feel pain, sorrow or regret for something done or spoken; as, to *repent* that we have lost much time in idleness or sensual pleasure; to *repent* that we have injured or wounded the feelings of a friend. A person repents only of what he himself has done or said. 2. To express sorrow for something past. Enobarbus did before thy face *repent*

- **3.** To change the mind in consequence of the inconvenience or injury done by past conduct. Lest peradventure the people *repent* when they see war, and they return. Exodus 13:17
- **4.** Applied to the Supreme Being, to change the course of providential dealings. Genesis 6:7. Psalms 106:45.
- **5.** In theology, to sorrow or be pained for sin, as a violation of God's holy law, a dishonor to his character and government, and the foulest ingratitude to a Being of infinite benevolence.

Repentance: Trusting in God for salvation through Jesus Christ alone. Turning from your unrighteousness and trusting that Jesus Christ is 100% the way to salvation and nothing you can do apart from faith can please God. God will examine your works of repentance and faith and send the holy Ghost if you are a true believer.

Have you confessed to God that you can do nothing without Jesus Christ?

I asked Jesus Christ to save me after reading some passages out of the AV1611. I confessed that Satan was ruling me and I could do nothing to save myself. I asked him to kill me or cure me.

Acts 26:20

But shewed first vnto them of Damascus, and at Hierusalem, and thorowout all the coasts of ludea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turne to God, and do works meete for repentance.

Acts 3:26

Unto you first, God hauing raised vp his Sonne lesus, sent him to blesse you, in turning away euery one of you from his iniquities.

Acts 2:38

Then Peter said vnto them, Repent, and be baptized euery one of you in the Name of lesus Christ, for the remission of sinnes, and ye shal receive the gift of the holy Ghost.

Rev 16:11...and repented not of their deeds.

Rev 9:20... repented not of the works of their hands...

Rev 9:21 Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts.

Rev 2:22...except they repent of their deeds.

2 Cor 12:21...and haue not repented of the vncleannesse, and fornication, and lasciulousnesse which they haue committed.

2 Cor 7:10...For godly sorrow worketh repentance to saluation...

Acts 26:20...that they should repent and turne to God, and do works meete for repentance.

Mark 1:15...repent ye, and beleeue the Gospell.

Ezekiel 18:30

Therefore I will iudge you, O house of Israel, euery one according to his wayes, saith the Lord God; repent, and turne your selues from all your transgressions: so iniquitie shall not be your ruine.

Ezekiel 3:19

Yet if thou warne the wicked, and he turne not from his wickednesse, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity, but thou hast deliuered thy soule.

Ezekiel 33

14 Againe, when I say vnto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die, if hee turne from his sinne, and do that which is lawfull and right; 15 If the wicked restore the pledge, giue againe that he had robbed, walke in the Statutes of life without committing iniquitie, hee shall surely liue, hee shall not die. 16 None of his sinnes that hee hath committed, shall be mentioned vnto him: he hath done that which is lawfull and right; he shall surely liue.

Dan 9:13

As it is written in the Law of Moses, all this euill is come vpon vs: yet made we not our prayer before the Lord our God, that we might turne from our iniquities, and vnderstand thy trueth.

Hos 14:2

Take with you words, and turne to the Lord, say vnto him, Take away all iniquitie, and receive vs graciously: so will wee render the calues of our lips.

Proverbs 28:13

He that couereth his sinnes, shall not prosper: but who so confesseth and forsaketh them, shall haue mercie.

James 2:24 Ye see then, how that by workes a man is justified, and not by faith only.

- 1. Men must repent or they will perish (Luke 13:3)
- 2. God calls sinners to repent (Mark 2:17)
- 3. We are unrighteous without Jesus (Romans 3:10)
- 4. All unrighteousness is sin (1 John 5:17)
- 5. Of those professing a belief in Jesus, few get saved (Mat 7:14)

In the bible God calls men (sinners) to repent of their unrighteousness (sin.)

Salvation is by believing the Gospel, accepting the free gift of the Lamb's righteousness because we have none to offer. We are saved by Grace through faith, not of works. Man cannot work righteousness which is what Babylon teaches. The holy Ghost is sent to those who believe the incorruptible Word of God.

Repentance is turning to God and trusting by faith in His righteousness because we have acknowledged our sin problem.

We cannot stop sinning in the flesh ever which is why we need the Lamb's righteousness.
